Seasoned with salt and pepper and dipped in cornmeal and egg



One of the World's most loved comfort foods



Created by thinly slicing potatoes without going all the way through



First offered to consumers in North America in 1912 in Hanson, Massachusetts



Invented by Dorcas Reilly in the 1950s and is a popular Thanksgiving side dish



An Italian specialty and is trademarked for it's thick and creamy consistency



Made from mayo and shredded cabbage

The main ingredient in this dish is first boiled, then mashed, seasoned, and fried



This plant is tall with a stout stem and feathery foliage



After cooking, it can be raked with a fork to resemble another food



Most commonly eaten in the Midwestern and Southern United States



A traditional North African grain that is traditionally served after being steamed with herbs



This vegetable is a member of the same group of plants that also includes Kale, Turnip, and Mustard



A perfect side for any picnic



Made with corn and a shelled bean. Traditional recipes recommend also using Lima beans.



A traditional french stewed vegetable side dish, typically containing eggplant, onion, zucchini, tomato, and peppers
