



Let's make some ice (shaving) cream!

Supplies

- shaving cream (Barbasol recommended, as long as it immediately foams up white)
- food coloring
- cardboard or paper to make a triangular ice cream cone
- paintbrush
- blank paper
- glue

Steps

1. Spray some shaving cream into a small bowl (optional: add Elmer's liquid glue to make it extra sticky and hold together better)
 2. Add food coloring to achieve desired ice cream flavor, mix together
 3. Create a triangular cone with paper or cardboard and glue to paper, towards the bottom with the pointy end down
 4. Use a paintbrush to plop the dyed shaving cream onto the paper above the cone
- **Tip! Shaving cream has great texture and ability to pile up to really look 3 dimensional, so play around and see how you can make the ice cream pop off the paper!****



Looks good enough to eat! **But don't!** Let it dry and hang it on your wall!
